MERCHANT MARINE (DECK) OFFICER**

The upcoming events and deadlines related to the Class IV, III, II, and I (Deck) examinations.

1. Announcement of Deck Exam Result (July 2026 Term):

The results of the Class IV, III, II, and I examinations will be announced on 10 September 2026.

2. Submission of Exam Files to the MMD (October 2026 Term):

The submission of files to the Mercantile Marine Department (MMD) for examination will commence from 11 September 2026 until 30 September 2026.

3. Deadline for Notice of Eligibility (NOE) File Submission (October 2026 Term):

The last date for the submission of files to obtain NOE is 25 August 2026.

4. NOE Issue Date (October 2026 Term):

The NOE for eligible candidates will be issued on 10 September 2026. Candidates are advised to collect their NOE from the CNS Office, DG (P&S) during office hours.

5. Commencement of Examinations (October 2026 Term):

The written examination of all classes will be held from 12 October to 22 October 2026.

❖ Rules for the Examinations of Masters and Mates

Following qualifying conditions are to be met before first time appearing in the examination as per NOE issued.

Applicable to Class-1 and Class-2 Candidates. (II/2 of STCW-78)

1. Valid General Operating Certificate for GMDSS;
2. Radar & ARPA Navigation – Management Level Certificate;
3. Medical Care Certificate;
4. ECDIS – Management Level;
5. Medical Fitness from approved medical practitioners; and
6. Valid Sight Test Certificate, (Letter Test/Lantern Test), valid for two years.

Applicable to Class-3 and/or Class-4 Candidates. (II/1 of STCW-78)

1. Valid General Operating Certificate for GMDSS or proof of admission;
2. Radar & ARPA Navigation – Operational Level Certificate;
3. Medical First Aid certificate;
4. Certificate of Proficiency in Survival Craft and Rescue Boats;
(other than fast rescue boats)
5. Efficient Deck Hand certificate;
6. Advanced Fire Fighting certificate;
7. ECDIS – Operational Level;
8. Medical Fitness from approved medical practitioners;
9. Valid Sight Test Certificate, (Letter Test/Lantern Test), valid for two years; and
10. All Basic Safety Courses.

Note: CoC will not be issued until the candidate possesses all above valid certificates.
