RECRUITMENT RULES FOR TECHNICAL POSTS:

S.R.O. 19 (IC)/80:

In pursuance of sub-rule (2) of rule 3 of the Civil Servants (Appointment, Promotion and Transfer) Rules, 1973, the following method, qualifications and other conditions are laid down for appointment to the posts of Director of Shipping, Director of Ports and Administration, Director of Projects and Assistant Statistical Officer in the Ministry of Communications (Ports and Shipping Wing) :-

2. Method of appointment.—(a) Subject to the provision of sub-para (b) of this paragraph the posts of Director of Shipping (Grade 19) Director of Ports and Administration (Grade 19) and Director of Projects (Grade 19) will be filled by promotion. In case no candidate is found suitable for promotion, the post/posts shall be filled by direct recruitment in accordance with rule 5 and failing that by transfer/deputation/re-employment in accordance with rule 4.

(b) As the exigencies of public service may warrant, the incumbents of the posts of Director are interchangeable.

(c) The post of Assistant Statistical Officer (Grade 17) will be filled by direct recruitment.

3. Promotion to posts mentioned in column 1 below shall be made by selection from amongst the persons who hold the posts mentioned in column 2 on regular basis and fulfil conditions laid down in column 3.

4. Qualifications/Conditions for Transfer/Deputation/Re-Employment :

- (i) Appointment by transfer shall be made from amongst the employees of the Attached/Subordinate Offices of the Ministry of Communications (Ports and Shipping Wing) like the Mercantile Marine Department, Shipping Office, Controller of Shipping, etc.
- (ii) In case no officer is found suitable under sub-para (i) appointment shall be made by transfer/deputation from Pakistan Navy.
- Appointment by transfer/deputation shall be made from amongst those persons who hold appointment on regular basis in the same grade in which the post is to be filled, exists and possess the qualifications and experience prescribed in the Schedule to this Notification for the purpose of direct recruitment.
- (iii) In case no suitable officer is found under sub-clause (ii) also retired officers of the Pakistan Navy possessing the qualifications, experience and age prescribed in the Schedule to this Notification for the purpose of direct recruitment shall be eligible for Re-employment.

5. Qualifications, Experience and Age-Limit for Direct Recruitment. A candidate must possess the qualifications and experience and the age-limits as mentioned in the Schedule to this Notification.

Provided that the maximum age-limit will be relaxed by 3 years in the case of candidates belonging to Scheduled Casts, Buddhist Community, recognised tribes of the Tribal Area, Azad Kashmir, Gilgit Agency and Balistan and provided further that for Government servants who have completed at least 2 years, maximum age-limit may be relaxed by not more than 10 years upto the age of 55 years.

The prescribed conditions including qualifications, experience age-limits etc. will be followed strictly but in case the Commission is unable to find a suitable candidate with the prescribed qualifications and the Department has certified that it is inescapable to make the appointment, the Commission will have the discretion to relax the prescribed conditions including experience to the extent it may consider necessary to avoid failure.

6. Probation.—Persons appointed to any of these posts shall excepting those appointed by deputation, be on probation for a period of one year. This period may be curtailed for good and sufficient reasons to be recorded, or if considered necessary, it may be extended for a period not exceeding one year. Appointment on probation shall be subject to the provisions of Article 6 of Civil Servants Act, 1973.

7. This notification issues with the concurrence of the Establishment Division and Federal Public Service Commission.
