Probation.—Persons appointed by promotion, initial appointment or transfer shall be on probation for a period of one year. This period may be curtailed for good sufficient reasons to be recorded, or if considered necessary, it may be extended for a period not exceeding one year as may be prescribed at the time of appointment. Appointment on probation shall be subject to the provision of section 6 of the Civil Servants Act, 1973 read with Rule 21 of the Civil Servant (Appointment, Promotion and Transfer) Rules, 1973.

7. This Notification issues with concurrence of the Establishment Division vide their O.M. No. 3|2|88-R-5, dated 19th June, 1999 and of the Federal Public Service Commission vide their letter No. F. 12-10|99-S, dated 24th January, 2001, and supersedes Ministry of Communications Notification No. 316|939|49, dated 3rd January, 1951.

2. Method of Appointment.—The method of appointment to the posts shall be as under :—

Provided that if no suitable person is available for promotion, the post or posts reserved for promotion shall be filled by initial appointment and failing that by transfer.

3. Condition for Promotion.—Promotion to posts in column 2 below shall be made by selection from amongst the persons who hold the posts specified in column 3 on a regular basis and possess the qualification and experience prescribed in column 4 :—

4. Qualifications, Experience and age Limits for Initial Appointment.—A candidate must possess the educational qualifications and experience and must be within the age limits mentioned against the post concerned in the schedule to this Notifications provided that :—

- (i) "Experience" means, the experience gained in a regular full time paid job after attaining the prescribed basic qualification.
- (ii) The maximum age limit shall be relaxed in respect of the candidates specified and to the extent indicated in the Initial Appointment to Civil posts (Relaxation of Upper Age Limit) Rules 1993, as amended from time to time ; and
- (iii) Eligibility of candidates shall be reckoned, as on the closing date fixed for submission of applications, in accordance with these Recruitment Rules and the instructions issued by the Federal Government and the Federal Public Service Commission from time to time.

5. Appointment by Transfer.—Appointment by transfer shall be made by selection from amongst the persons holding appointment on a regular basis under the Federal Government in the same pay scale in which the post to be filled exists, provided that the person concerned possesses the qualifications and experience prescribed for initial appointment or promotion to the post concerned.
