2. The aforesaid program is subject to amendment; therefore candidates are advised to have the Examination Time Table confirmed one week before the commencement of examinations of respective class from the Office of the Chief Examiner of Engineers, Ministry of Maritime Affairs (Ports & Shipping Wing), Karachi. In case of closed holiday, the examination of the affected subject shall be held on the following day just after the prescribed schedule of written examinations. The schedule for Oral Examination of Class 1, 2 & 4 Certificate of Competency will be intimated after written examination.

3. Candidates wishing to appear in Examination for Certificate of Competency as (Marine Engineer Officer) Class - I, II & IV, may submit their application for **ELIGIBILITY** along-with relevant documents and prescribed fees at Mercantile Marine Department, at least 30 days before commencement of examination.

4. Candidates who have passed their respective examination must collect the **RESULT SHEET** within 15 days after the announcement of result.

5. Any candidate who has applied for the examination of Marine Engineer Officer and remains absent from any part of the Examination for any reason will be marked **ABSENT**. Candidate will be required to make a fresh application and deposit the prescribed fee for the appropriate grade of examination as per rules.

6. Application Forms for the Examination, complete in all respect, should be submitted through Mercantile Marine Department, Karachi at least two weeks before the examination.

7. Application forms of candidates without previous marks sheet/result card, except appearing with first attempt, will be rejected.
