Subject: Schedule of examinations for certificate of competency — marine engineer officer (classes i, ii & iv) and ETO/Electrical Engineer September -2026

It is hereby notified to all candidates intending to appear in the Examinations for Certificate of Competency as **Marine Engineer Officer (Class I, II and IV)** and **Electro-Technical Officer (ETO)**, that the examinations shall be conducted at the Examination Centre of the Ports & Shipping Wing, Mercantile Marine Department (MMD), Karachi, on the dates set out in the schedule below.

IMPORTANT

- **Reporting time:** All examinations shall commence at **10:00 AM sharp**.
- **Duration:** Each written paper is of **three (03) hours**, except *Engineering Drawing*, which is of **four (04) hours**.

2. The schedule set out above is **provisional** and liable to amendment. Candidates are therefore advised to confirm the examination timetable for their respective class **at least one week before** the commencement of examinations from the Office of the Chief Examiner of Engineers, Ministry of Maritime Affairs (Ports & Shipping Wing), Karachi. In the event that a gazetted or public holiday falls on a scheduled examination day, the affected paper shall be conducted at the end of the prescribed examination schedule to ensure that the timetable of other papers remains unaffected. The schedule for oral examinations of Class I, II and IV shall be notified separately after the conclusion of the written examinations.
3. Candidates wishing to appear in the examination shall submit an application for **determination of eligibility**, together with the prescribed supporting documents and fees, to the Mercantile Marine Department, Karachi, **Until before the commencement of the relevant examination.**
4. After determination of eligibility, the **final Application Form for Examination**, complete in all respects, shall be submitted to the Mercantile Marine Department, Karachi, until August 17, 2026.
5. Applications submitted without the previous marks sheet or result card shall be **rejected**, save in the case of candidates appearing in the first attempt.
6. A candidate who, having applied for the examination, **remains absent** from any paper for any reason whatsoever shall be marked "**ABSENT**". Such a candidate shall be required to submit a fresh application and deposit the prescribed fee for the relevant grade of examination, as per the rules in force.
7. Successful candidates shall **collect the Result Sheet** from the Mercantile Marine Department, Karachi, within **fifteen (15) days** of the official announcement of the result.
